Educause Center for Applied Research (ECAR) Study of Undergraduate Students & Technology

In the spring of 2012, The Educause Center for Applied Research (ECAR) collaborated with 195 institutions to collect responses from more than 100,000 students about their technology experiences. The Office of Institutional Research was responsible for creating a representative pool of Saint Rose undergraduate students for the survey. The Saint Rose final response rate was 15% based on a response of 412 students on a sample of 2,730 students. The overall national survey response rate was 9%.

As is often the case, the open-ended responses provide a great deal of qualitative information about how Saint Rose undergraduate students feel about technology.
